



Refine gross and fine motor skills with integrated movement activities, opportunities for tracing, cutting, coloring, pre-writing / early writing, and active play.




Communication and Language Development

Support age-appropriate independence with routines that promote self-care skills like buttoning, handwashing, managing materials, and transitioning between tasks.




Emerging Literacy Skills

Why is Kindergarten Readiness Important?



Early intervention and exposure to learning experiences, like preschool, structured play, and family engagement, can help prepare children for kindergarten.
