Curriculum and Program Components

Launch for PreK uses a thematic approach to provide equitable access to early childhood content and instruction where all children learn together and at their own pace. Theme-based instruction allows teachers to address developmentally-appropriate skills for students with diverse learning needs and abilities. Instruction is fresh and engaging each week as students work toward mastery of learning goals at their own pace.

There are 72 total themes designed to be covered over the course of 2 school years, with each theme covering one week of preschool instruction. The key curriculum components, including the types of lesson plans, media library, manipulatives, and more, are described on the following pages.

Activity-Based Lesson Plans


Each theme includes 8 variations of classroom-based activity lesson plans with leveled differentiation (P1, P2, and P3). The lesson plans include instruction and activities for full-day, five-day-per-week PreK programs, and can be adjusted to fit the needs of partial day programs as well. Sample/suggested schedules, scope and sequences, and more are provided.



Also included: Teacher Guides, parent communication supports (weekly theme letters for families in English/Spanish), and optional worksheets for advanced students.

Includes the PreK Children's Library, Songs, and Visual Supports Library.



Innovative Differentiation

With **internally adaptable text**, teachers have the ability to adjust the text complexity and length according to their students' needs. Teachers may choose to differentiate based on their students' readiness to learn. This may shift based on the time of day, number of students in the group, or time during the school year.

ORIGINAL SONGS

Launch for PreK includes a song library with classic nursery rhymes and original theme songs and classroom songs that are available with lyrics and as instrumentals. Through the student login, families can access the songs at home for continued learning and fun together!

- Classic Nursery Rhyme and Finger Play Songs, like Five Little Ducks, London Bridge is Falling Down, and The More We Get Together
- Theme Songs that compliment the week's theme, such as Apple in a Tree, Busy City, Quiet Country, and Jungle Canopy
- Classroom Songs that support transitions and classroom routines, such as End of the Day, Good Morning to You, Letter A Song

Manipulative Kit and Theme Kit



Differentiation to Meet the Developmental Needs of ALL Learners

Launch for PreK includes 3 levels of differentiation throughout the entire curriculum: every lesson plan and every activity is accessible to every learner.

The 3 differentiated levels correspond to different developmental ranges, with Level P3 serving students who are ready for the most independence, including opportunities to extend lesson activities that appropriately challenge them. Level P1 is designed for students who benefit from the most support – the lesson plans guide teachers to meet these students where they are at and guide them forward in developmentally appropriate ways.

The visual below shows the developmental progression and corresponding differentiation.



In most states, early learning standards are broken down into the developmental continuum that students progress through to achieve the full standards. Launch for PreK's full scope and sequence includes the overarching standards (what the child should be doing by the time they are developmentally 48-60 months) and all of the earlier developing steps of the skill leading up to it. By differentiating the curriculum according to developmental milestones, Launch for PreK makes learning accessible to students with developmental delays and disabilities as well as typically developing students.




