TeachTown's Coaching Cohort Model provides specialized training in enCORE implementation for a select group of teachers. **The goal is to build their capacity to effectively implement all parts of enCORE in their classrooms and be equipped to mentor other teachers in their district.**

The Cohort Coaching Model consists of **3 one-hour onsite coaching sessions** to occur at the beginning, middle, and end of the school year and **2 virtual coaching sessions** between onsite sessions to occur two to three weeks after coaching session.

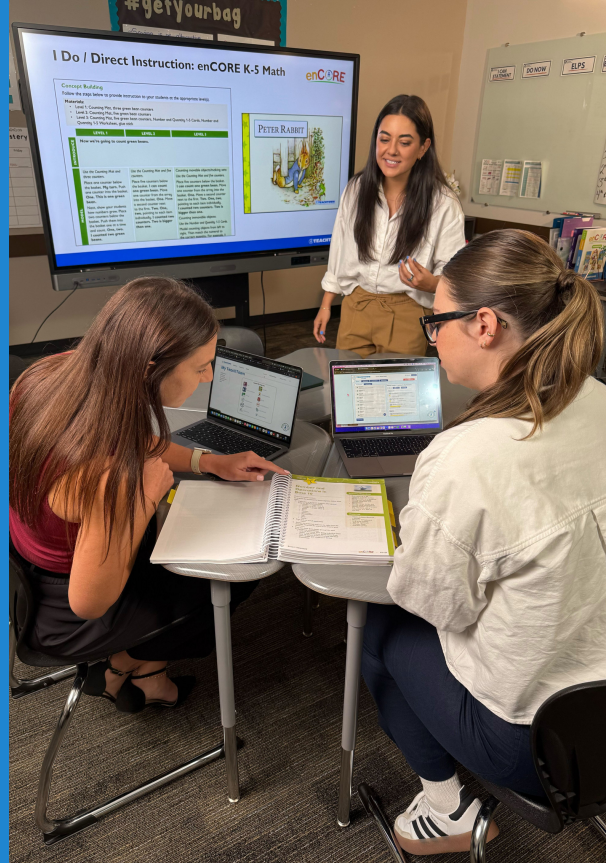

Prerequisites & Expectations

Each cohort will be conducted with the same pre-selected teachers for the entire year and consist of a maximum of 5 teachers per day per TeachTown trainer.

Before getting started, districts must meet the following criteria:

- ✓ Preselect teachers for the coaching cohort
- ✓ Teachers must have completed enCORE 101-103 trainings with TeachTown in prior years
- ✓ Teachers participate in a coaching onboarding meeting with the Customer Success Manager and Customer Enablement Specialist to set coaching goals



In addition, teachers and administrators agree to the following expectations:

DISTRICT ADMINISTRATION
